Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Seminary has received additional federal funds as part of the CARES Act Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF). The Seminary has allocated a portion of these funds to be used for a one-time need based grant to students for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the pandemic.
